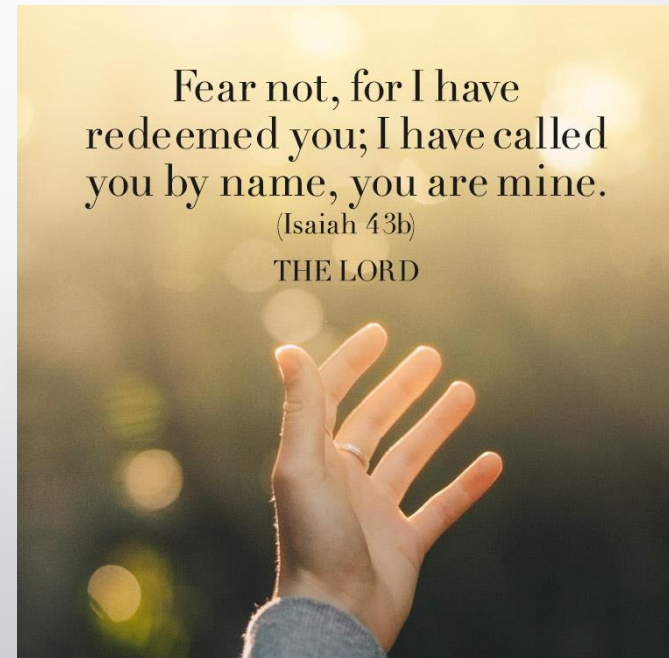
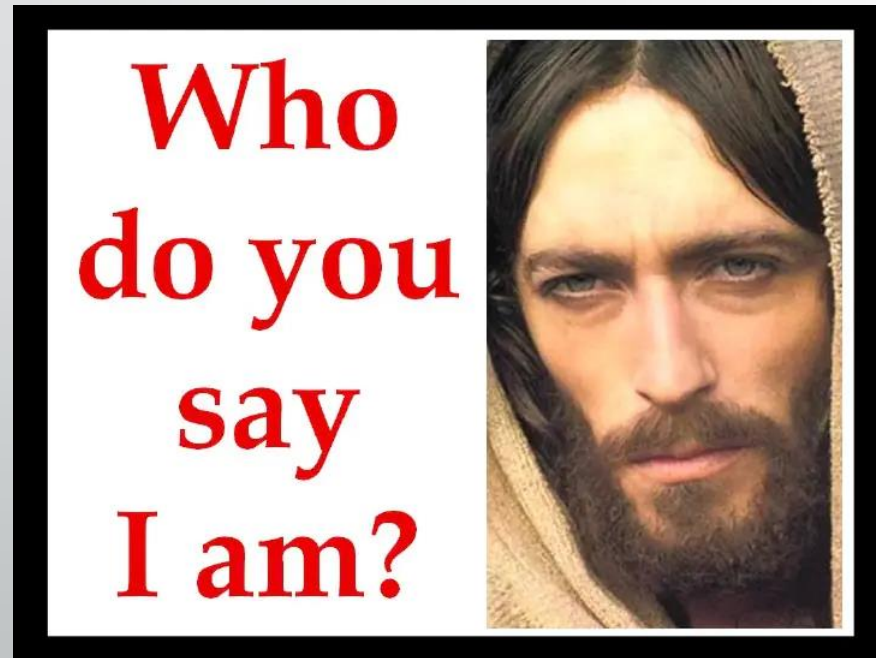


What's in a name?

- Many families have names that are passed from one generation to another.
- Invite families to explore some the names that are part of their families. Get them to explore the history of the name and person with that name.
- Young parents have to 'choose' a name – encourage the use of Christian names – names with a Christian history
- Confirmation Candidates – have to choose a name...
- Who are the saints that inspire you, maybe an ancient one locally or someone from recent history?
- Have a parish/school based project to highlight some saints who have lit up our history? Why are they attractive? What can they teach you and your family?

- **Find out why you were called by the name you are know....**

Mini Reflection on our Names

'Rejoice that your names are written in heaven.'
(Luke 10:20)

A period of silence....

- Invite people to say something about their name? If they know why it was chosen or changed this can be shared. How do you feel about your name? Have you a nickname or a preferred way to be called?

Reflection

What's in a name? Do we respect the name of God? 'Thou shall not take the name of God in vain....' 'Hallowed by thy name...' 'His name will be called Jesus....'

Each of our names are precious. There is a story that goes with our names. We are taught that 'God calls each of us by name. Everyones name is sacred. The name is the icon of the person.'
(Catechism 2158)

Respect for Names....

- How often has some heard, 'sorry I've forgotten your name...'?
- How often have you been called by another name, or it is misspelled or pronounced incorrectly?
- Think of the people who 'treasure' your name...
- How do you react when you hear your name spoken?
- Can you imagine how God names and calls you...?
- Just as God named people in the Bible, he also names each of us.....

Called by Name

- 'Do not fear I have redeemed you. I have called you by name, you are mine.' (Isaiah 43:1)
- 'Can a mother forget I will not forget you, I have inscribed you in the palm of my hand.' Isaiah 49:15-16
- 'I will give them an everlasting name.' Is 56:5
- 'You shall be called by a new name that the mouth of the Lord will give...' Is 62:2
- Think of the people that Jesus called... by Name....Levi... Mary... Simon... Martha...Lazarus....
- Imagine Jesus calling you by name....to be his disciple...
- How does this make you feel to know Jesus calls you by your name.....?

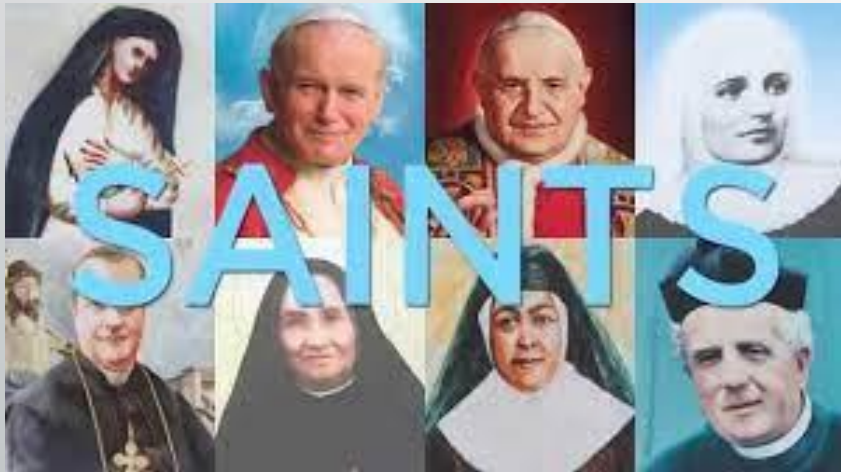


Christus Vivit – Chapter 2 Jesus Ever Young- Exploring Young Saints who inspired!
